# The 2021 round of External Quality Assessments (EQA)

- **9 different Proficiency Tests** (PT) were run:
  - 2 Screening: Rapid test for BSE and for scrapie (RB21, RS21)
  - 3 Confirmatory: **Immunoblot** for BSE and scrapie (WB21, WS21) & **PrP immunohistochemistry interpretation** (IHC-I21)
  - 2 Discriminatory: Discriminatory western blot in bovine and in small ruminants (DB21 & DS21)
  - 2 Genotyping: **PRNP genotyping** in sheep and in goats (GS21, GG21)

• The 2021-2022 was a period of **assistance and dialogue** with the NRLs. The following countries requested some help or exchange views:


Croatia, Finland, France, Germany, Ireland, Latvia, Norway, Portugal, Romania and Sweden

## Project for propagation of Atypical BSE

Since their discovery (2004), the overall EU caseload of L-BSE and H-BSE has been very small (65 and 60 cases respectively).

## Project for propagation of Atypical BSE

- The scarcity of reference materials of atypical BSE (both L-type and H-type BSE) is one of the main concerns for the continuation of the activities related to interlaboratory comparative testing and batch testing.
- Based on preliminary contacts with Friedrich-Loeffler-Institut (FLI, German TSE NRL), a joint project for the production of reference material is being prepared.

## Project for propagation of Atypical BSE

Challenges that were/are being addressed:

- amount of reference material needed and the resulting number of calves entered for the challenge,
- administrative tasks for the animal welfare approval of the experiment, preparation of the stables,
- finding animal caretakers and a veterinarian to supervise the experiment, finding suitable calves, designing protocols for the collection, transfer and storage of samples and for the final cleaning and disinfection of the animal facility at the end of the study period.

## The project in a nutshell

- 6-10 calves will be challenged for each type of atypical BSE at 4-6 months of age.
- This involves the inoculation of 1 ml of 10% homogenate per animal intracerebr.
- After inoculation, the animals will undergo clinical examinations (weekly), blood sampling (monthly) and cerebrospinal fluid collection (every six months).
- The confirmation of BSE infections and subsequent collection of reference materials at necropsy will take place after 20 months.

Based on an exploratory estimate of the reference material required annually for EQAs and batch testing, this activity should be sufficient to make enough material available to


